The subject of the video can be about your summer break, a short film or a PSA. You are ALWAYS allowed to do more then the assignment requires. If you would like to work on a bigger project, all you need to do is ask me for permission.

## **Grading Rubric**

Length - Must be between 1:15 and 1:30	100 points
Storytelling - The story must make sense and have a beginning middle and end.	100 points
Length - Must be between 1:15 and 1:30	100 points
Lighting - All subjects must be properly lit.	100 points
Camera Work - Use several different angles, establishing, wide, medium, tight, close up, extreme close up, OTS, POV etc... and use the rule of 3rds. If there is only one camera shot or you shoot in portrait mode, you will receive a ZERO. If you use	100 points

pictures downloaded from the internet, you will receive a ZERO. Adhere to copyright laws.	
Audio - Interviews, dialogue and voice overs. Record in a quiet place. ONLY add music if it enhances the story. If there is no dialogue or V/O, you will receive a ZERO. Adhere to copyright laws.	100 points
Creativity - The story and video must be interesting and creative.	100 points
Effort - Make a video that you are proud to show others and has the standards I expect. This cannot be done last minute. DO NOT wait until the last minute.	100 points
Overall - A combination of all the above categories.	100 points

Extra credit:

You will receive extra credit points if you submit a storyboard and script.

Use all the information and standards you learned during the school year. You may use any camera or smartphone to shoot and can edit with any software accessible to you on your smartphone or computer. There are many free video editing softwares available, for example Adobe's Rush, Videolicious or Google's WeVideo or even the public library has computers and software available. Your entire project will be comprised of videos you recorded.

Only one Summer Video Project per student is required.
